116th IATP Conference in Shenyang, P.R. China on October 14-18, 2017: Highlights

The 116th IATP Conference, hosted by China Southern Airlines and supported by Guangzhou Aircraft Maintenance Engineering Co., Ltd. (GAMECO), was held at Shangri-La Hotel Shenyang, from October 14th to 18th, 2017.

During the conference, more than 1,200 meetings were scheduled among the 400 representatives from 106 Airline Members, 33 Associate Members, and various authorized vendors. The goal was to identify new pooling opportunities and/or negotiate terms and conditions of pooling contracts for the forthcoming season. The participants also had the opportunity to attend sessions aimed at providing updates about IATP pooling activities and the aviation industry in general.

- The Management Committee met not only Mr. Wang Guangsheng, Vice Mayor of Shenyang Municipal People's Government, but also Mrs. Cao Xiaoling, Mr. Wang Weihua and Mr. Tian Jia, from the Shenyang Aviation Industry Group, Liaoning Airport Management Group, and Shenyang Economic & Information Technology Commission respectively. Shenyang's future development, especially the expansion of aviation-related activities, was discussed.
- The participants were pleased to know that, based on IATP Members' recommendations, IATA AGSA Technical Group voted in favour of the removal of any reference to Service Level Agreements (SLA) in SGHA maintenance contracts.
