115th IATP Conference in Dublin, Ireland on March 11 – 15, 2017: Highlights

The 115th IATP Conference was held at Clayton Hotel Burlington Road, from March 11th to 15th, 2017, and was supported by AerLingus and Storm Aviation. More than 450 participants attended the event, which was held in Europe for the first time in three years.

During the conference, nearly 1,450 meetings were scheduled among representatives from the 100+ Airline Members, 30+ Associate Members, and various authorized vendors. The aim was to identify new pooling opportunities and/or negotiate terms and conditions of pooling contracts for the forthcoming season. The participants also had the opportunity to attend sessions aimed at providing updates about the aviation industry.

Conference highlights:

- One Airline joined IATP as Member; we warmly welcome Brussels Airlines. Two vendors also joined the organization as Associate Members; welcome to Avtrade and Illuminair Support Corporation.
- Elections took place for three Management Committee positions. We are looking forward to working with the new Management Committee Members.
- The meetings held during the conference enabled IATP Members to share and discuss the issues related to the aviation industry, such as SLA requirements for line maintenance; IATP Members agreed that SLAs should not be used as it could expose the handlers to safety concerns.
- IATP invited Mr. Dragos Munteanu, IATA Europe Assistant Director Flight and Safety Operations, to present IATA Operational Safety Audit Program (IOSA) and in particular "measurable standards".
- IATP delegates were pleased to hear Mr. Davide Martini, EASA Cybersecurity Officer, presentation about the current cyberthreats and EASA action in cybersecurity.



The social events organized after the business days were highly appreciated by the participants as it enabled them to do some networking and expand their contacts.

The next IATP Conference will be held from October 14 to 18, 2017 in Shenyang, P.R. China.
